4. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Harlie's Hoops basketball court: roof color proposal. Steelscape has provided a product color sample for review by the Commission- the Champagne color is proposed for a metal roof covering. The commissioners have had a chance to review the color and profile of the proposed roof. Photos of the color installed on buildings have also been provided along with the product sheet.

The proposed roof structure has been approved as being compatible with the design and intended use and history of the Lake. Review has focused on ensuring that the structure is compatible with the surroundings and visual impacts are minimized to the extent possible.

From the standards for Rehabilitation:

"New additions, exterior alterations or related new construction will not destroy historic materials, features and spatial relationships that characterize the property. The new work will be differentiated from the old and will be compatible with the historic materials, features, size, scale and proportion, and massing to protect the integrity of the property and its environment."

From the Secretary of the Interior's Guidelines:

"Alterations/Additions for the New Use recommended.....

Designing and constructing new additions to historic buildings when required by the new use. New work should be compatible with the historic character of the setting in terms of size, scale design, material, color, and texture."
