3. WORKSHOP**20-000398 REVIEW 2021-2022 BUDGET ENHANCEMENTS**

City Manager Sacha presented the proposed budget enhancements for the 2021-2022 biennial budget. With the exception of one position in IT, the Council agreed to revisit the staffing related enhancements in Spring-Summer of 2021, in order to have a better understanding of the economic impact of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

Council supported including the following enhancement requests in the 2021-2022 biennial budget:

IT - Increase 80% FTE IT Tech (32F) to 100% FTE IT Analyst (10C)

CED - Permit Processing Software

Fire - Pumper Engine

Fire - Standard Operating Guideline (SOG) Software

Fire - Increase in Personal Protective Equipment

Fire - Upgrade Records Management System

Police - Behavioral Health Provider Contract

No final action was taken.

Mayor Pro Tem Wallin requested to be excused from the workshop scheduled for October 15th. There was no objection. In regards to the November meeting schedule, the Council will hold regular meetings on November 12th and November 19th due to the Thanksgiving holiday on the regular meeting night of November 26th.
