KLTV VIDEO TOUR OF DOWNTOWN TRANSIT CENTER**

Amy Asher presented the KLTV video tour of the new Downtown Transit Center to the board.

KLTV videotaped the grounds and facility on October 26, 2020. The new building is 4,300 square feet and includes the following improvements:

- Expanded breakroom;
- Additional office space;
- Training room;
- Full visibility of the Pedestrian Plaza from the customer service office.

Improvements outside the facility include:

- Reconfigured drive aisle;
- Improved Pedestrian Plaza;
- Upgraded bus shelters;
- Upgraded lighting;
- Perimeter fencing.

8. **MANAGER'S REPORT**

Amy Asher gave a brief report:

- RiverCities Transit is currently operating at full-service levels;
- Fixed Route ridership is at fifty percent of 2019 ridership levels;
- Staff is gathering information for the FTA Triennial Review. All paperwork for this review is due on December 18, 2020;
- Tabitha Hayden has updated the free Annual Youth Pass application for 2021;
- Staff is working with the County Health Department to plan for the upcoming free COVID-19 testing site. The staff has created a detour around the testing site so that buses can serve it without being impacted by potential traffic delays;
- The Longview City Council will meet Thursday, December 10, 2020, to consider the Interlocal Agreement approved by the Board at the November 18, 2020, CTA Board meeting.

Betsy Despain gave a brief report on Paratransit Ridership:

- Paratransit ridership numbers were down in November compared to October;
- Paratransit is retraining operators in blood borne pathogen safety, defensive driving, and other training requirements.

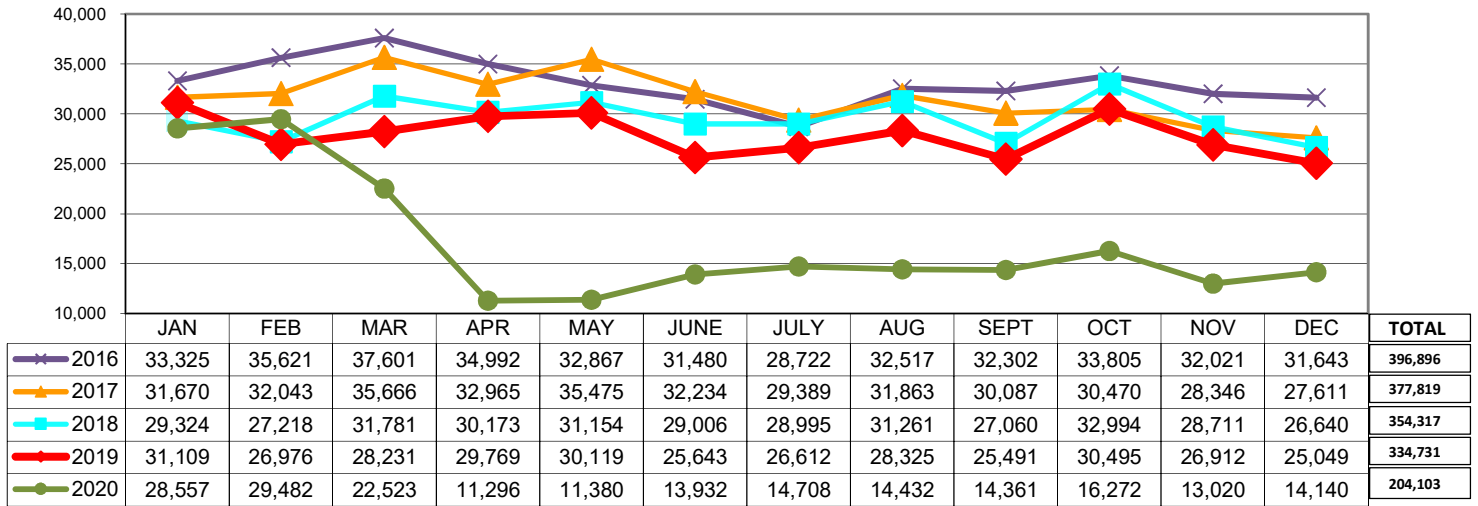

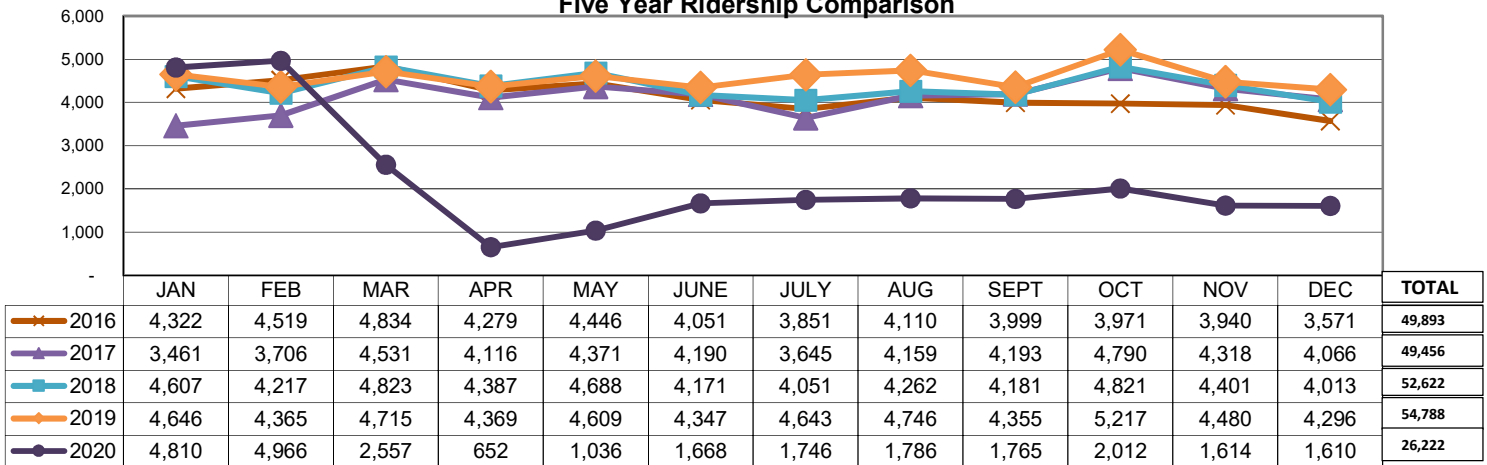

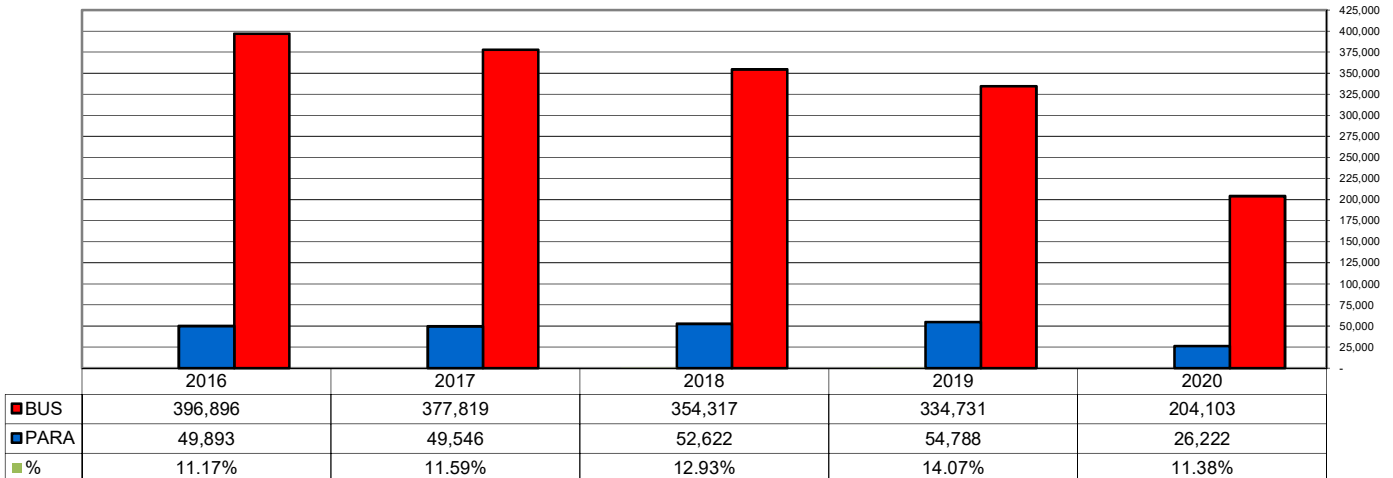
RiverCities Transit Fixed Route Five Year Ridership Comparison

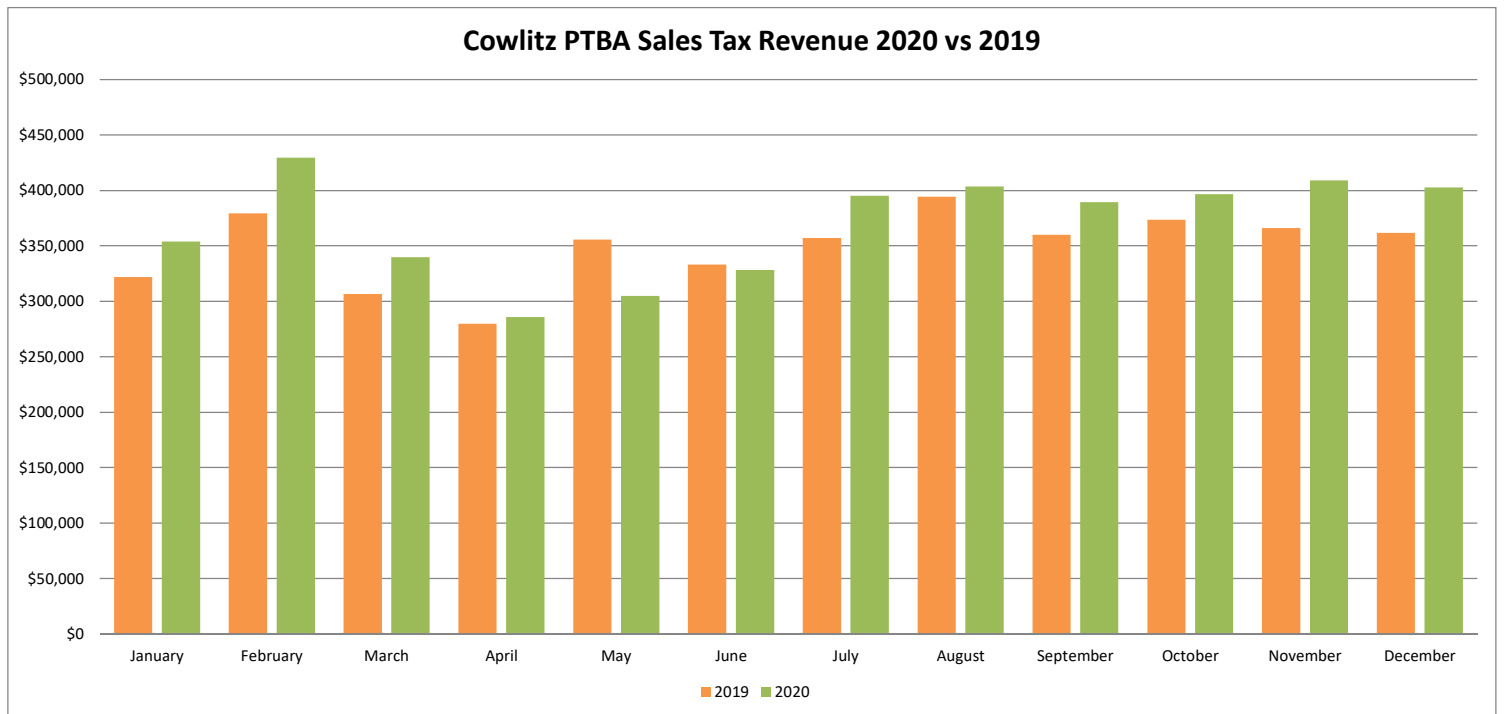
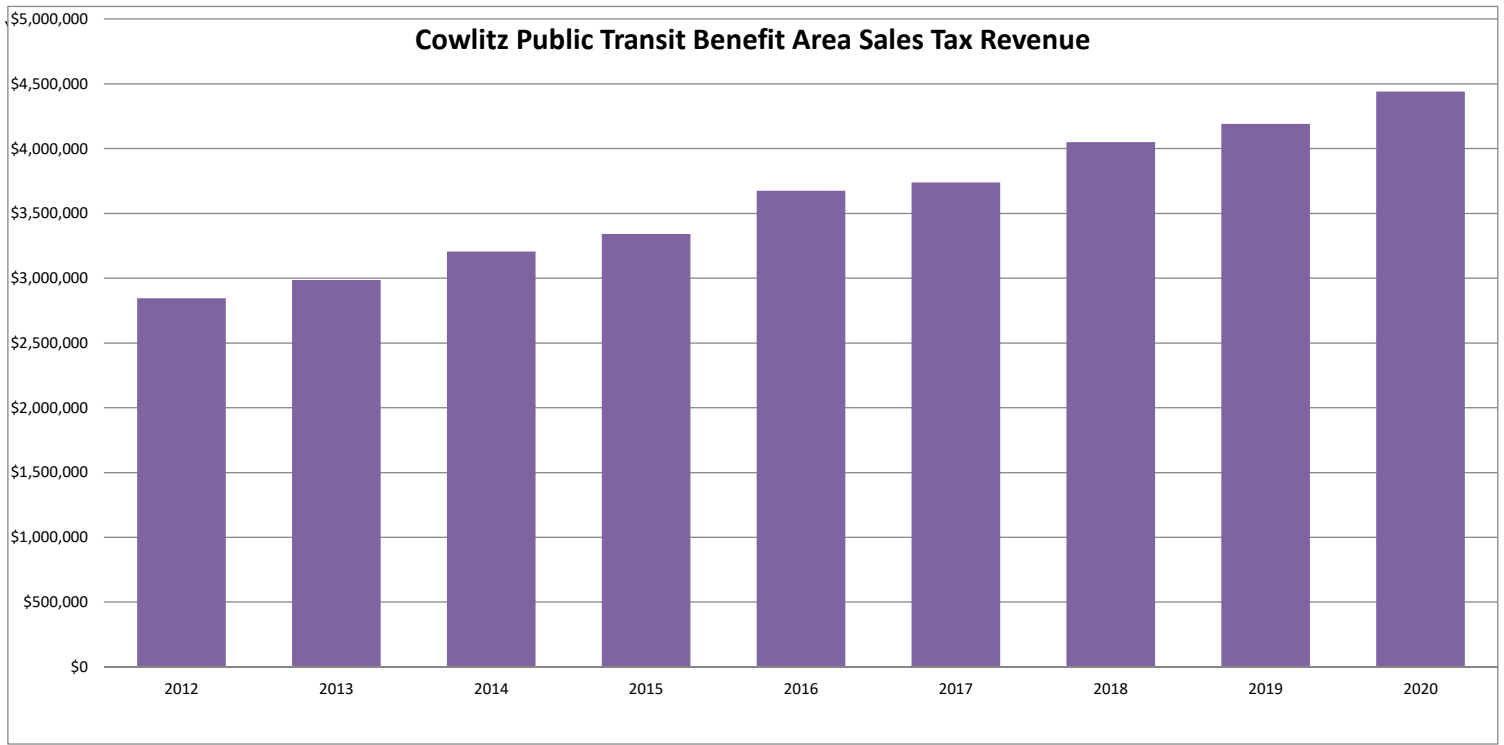


RiverCities Transit Paratransit Five Year Ridership Comparison
