- **APPROVAL OF MEETING NOTES**

A motion was made by George Winn, seconded by Dave Fine, that the notes be accepted and approved. Passed unanimously.

- **OLD BUSINESS**

- **KELSO – WEST MAIN PROJECT**

Karl Enyeart gave a brief updated on the status of getting a bike lane from West Main to Ocean Beach Highway. We are also working on getting the Cowlitz Way sign on the sign mast. It will be evaluated for wind load. To accomplish a bike lane from Washington Way to 15th on Ocean Beach Highway, we first need to a reduction of speed limit to 25 mph from Washington Way to 15th Avenue.

- **LONGVIEW BICYCLE PLAN**

Ken Hash introduced new engineer Morgan Palmer. Dave Fine reviewed the status of the bicycle plan subcommittee progress. Hope to meet in early March.

- **DIKE TRAIL UPDATE – KEN**

Ken Hash continues to speak with CDID #1 on adding more gravel to the dike trail. As of yet, this hasn't happened.

- 46TH AVENUE PROJECT UPDATE

Sam Barham noted that we are still in design phase with a plan to go out to bid in Spring 2022.

- BIKE RACKS - KEN

Ken Hash asked the group for someone to lead this project. Dave Fine, with Active Transportation, applied and received a \$3500 grant to be used for signage and bike racks primarily targeted for those that ride bike through Longview. Longview is on several bike touring group routes. Trey Davis, with Dave's assistance, would like to take the lead on this project.

- **NEW BUSINESS**

- COUNCIL WORKSHOP ON MARCH 11TH AT 6 PM TO DISCUSS THE WSDOT SR4 PLANNING STUDY – KEN

Ken Hash encouraged everyone to attend this zoom council workshop.

- RAILS TO TRAILS

Dave Fine inquired about the status of the old Weyerhaeuser railway. Ken Hash noted that there is an upcoming meeting with Patriot Rail and he is hopeful that this will be the discussion.

- IWOW PROJECT UPDATE – KEN

Ken Hash received updated images for the scope of the project. There is no bike lanes depicted in the artistic renderings. Oregon Way needs to have a bike lane that travels to the bridge.

- OREGON WAY TBD PROJECT UPDATE – KEN/SAM

Sam Barham shared the overall project scope – grind and inlay from Tennant Way to Baltimore Street. ADA curb ramp and bulb out at Cypress will also be added. Bike lane options were discussed, as there currently isn't space for one. A possible option would be a road diet.

- BICYCLE PAVEMENT MARKINGS – KEN

Ken Hash shared images of bicycle pavement markings. When the City proceeds with marking roadways, he would encourage community education and outreach, maybe even a printed

brochure, in our car centric community. George Winn agreed to lead the next topic. A suggestion of electric bikes was given.
