21-000663 Historic Grant application 2021: Sub-committee report.

Staff and Adam, Arthur and Nat have met and discussed a plan to request funds from the State DAHP Certified Local Government grant program to preserve and display original plans for the plan for Longview' drawn by Hare and Hare, notable landscape architects. The idea is to produce a lasting display on durable material such as aluminum or plexiglass. A new website for the Historic Preservation Program could also be a component of the request.

5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

21-000661 Request for a Certificate of Appropriateness: Library drive up window (window replacement) facing Maple St.

The Longview Public library has started a book pick up service and would like to continue this service next to the existing book drop located in a window opening facing Maple Street. The library has looked at replacing an existing window with a single hung replica window or a proper service window and shelf. At this time use of the existing drive-through lane is the best option which requires modifying an existing window. The service window option will consist of:

"A service window in a manual opening version, custom paint, split the transom for 2 lites wide, and add a 12" shelf on the exterior." The window will be glazed with 1/4" clear tempered glass and have transom lites over the service doors.

6. NEW BUSINESS

21-000660 HCA 2018-3 Harlie's Hoops basketball court at Lake Scajawea: request to modify certificate of appropriateness to waive requirement to clad support columns and or specify coverage of the exterior only.

The historic preservation commission approved the structure with a requirement for the applicant to provide a design for cladding the support columns with house siding or other compatible material approved by the HPC to help the building blend into the setting. The applicant informed the commission the project now requires additional fundraising to meet this requirement.

21-000662 Request for a certificate of appropriateness: remove appliance vent chimney on Longview Womens Club building.

The group visited the Longview Womens Club and saw that a small vent chimney located on the north middle side of the building by the Kitchen, that is no longer in service, is damaged and needs to be removed.
