- **APPROVAL OF MEETING NOTES**

A motion was made by Clark Carroll, seconded by Trey Davis, that the notes be accepted and approved. Passed unanimously.

- **OLD BUSINESS**

- COUNCIL WORKSHOP ON MARCH 11TH AT 6 PM TO DISCUSS THE WSDOT SR 4 PLANNING STUDY – KEN

This is a long range, 20 year outlook, planning study based on safety, mobility and economic development that was presented to the Council on March 11th. The Daily News article on Facebook created an opportunity for Ken Hash to engage with the public about roundabouts.

- RAILS TO TRAILS – KEN

The meeting Ken Hash had last month with Patriot Rails was with the operations and sales group , so there was no progress made there.

- IWOW PROJECT – KEN

The first federal grant application for the year was sent off for infragrants asking for \$ 13 million. Federal lobbyist thought it was

a great application but they are only giving out about 18 grants. We will have a better chance with the build grants coming out next month. The latest drawings presented recently do show connections multimodal transportation, including connecting to the Highlands Trail with sidewalks and bike lanes.

- OREGON WAY TBD PROJECT UPDATE – SAM

Sam Barham shared that it is going to Council this Thursday for final approval to go out to bid in April for construction. Discussion was had about bike route options including signage.

- BEECH STREET - KEN

Ken Hash mentioned that we are working with the contractor to get that project up and going again.

- BIKE RACKS – TREY

Trey Davis shared that Matt Carnahan has been working with Waite Machine and received a quote for materials. A good portion of the \$3500 grant that Dave Fine secured will go towards bike racks. Ken Hash was able to share on screen some sign designs they are working on creating and potential locations.

- LONGVIEW BICYCLE PLAN - DAVE

Morgan Palmer gave a brief update on the team working on the bike plan. The group just received their final chapter. Work has begun to compile one large draft. Great progress is being made.

- **NEW BUSINESS**

- AUTO-PEDESTRIAN COLLISION

George Winn inquired about the automobile-pedestrian collision at the corner of Nichols and Louisiana last week. He was curious if the speeds on Nichols have been reviewed recently. It is the highest speeds of the surrounding streets.

- **EDUCATION TOPIC**

- ELECTRIC BIKES – GEORGE

George Winn shared a variety of electric bikes and local opportunities for purchases. There is quite a range of costs and uses for e-bikes including hunting. There is a need for bike storage locations and charging stations. E-bikes offer a great assist while climbing hills. UPS utilizes bikes for delivers in Seattle. He spoke with a couple of local e-bike riders.

Morgan Palmer will be our next presenter with a topic of bikeway designs of Europe.

A short discussion was had about in person meetings again. We are following the lead of City Council. A hybrid model is being worked on, and when that is available, we could also utilize that option.

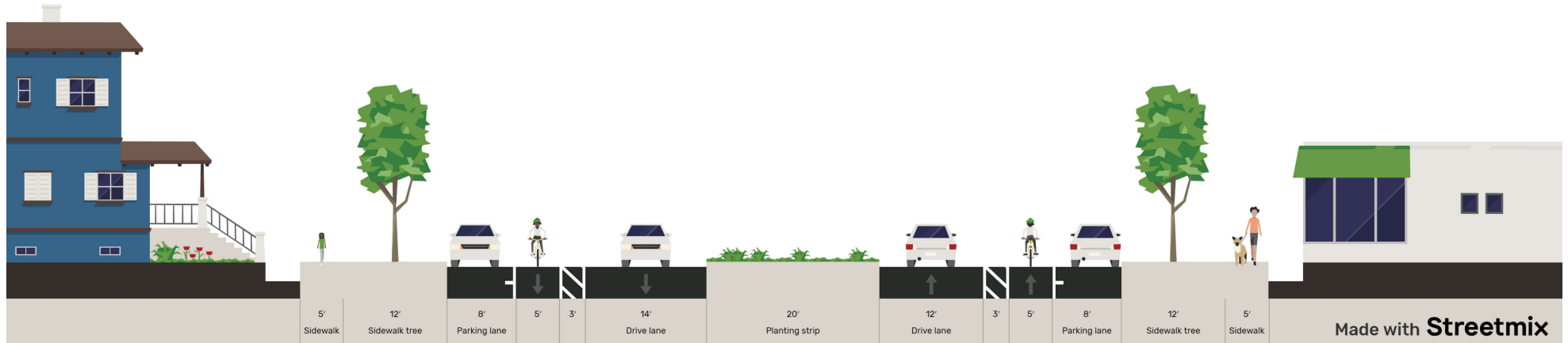

NARRATIVE

On 3/12/2021 at approx. 1526 hrs. officers were dispatched to the intersection of Kessler Blvd. and Louisiana St. for a report of a vehicle vs. pedestrian collision. At approx. 1527 hrs. I arrived on scene with Ofc. Weatherl. The collision actually occurred at the intersection of Louisiana St. and Nichols Blvd.

I observed two females lying on their right sides/back in the crosswalk with both of their heads facing to the north. These two pedestrians were later identified as Charity Shepard and Jeraldine Shepard. Both Charity and Jeraldine were tended to by aid crews and both were transported to St. John Medical Center for treatment with possible injuries.

The driver of Unit 1, identified as Donna B. Coe via WA driver's license remained in her vehicle during the investigation. Unit 1 was southbound on Nichols Blvd. and turned left onto eastbound Louisiana St., striking both Charity and Jeraldine who were in the crosswalk of Louisiana St. walking southbound.

There were several witnesses to the collision. The witnesses all had different vantage points. Vesta McCrandall was the first vehicle in line stopped for a red light eastbound on Louisiana St. at Nichols Blvd. She observed Unit 1 quickly turn in front of another vehicle traveling northbound on Nichols Blvd. (driven by another witness, Gary Blurton) and turn into the crosswalk striking both Charity and Jeraldine.

Two witnesses who were in the same vehicle, Eric Rushmer and Valori Rushmer said they were northbound on Nichols Blvd. They were stopped for a red light. Their light turned green so they proceeded into the intersection of Louisiana St. to travel north. They had to quickly stop because Unit 1 started to turn left onto Louisiana St. in front of them and started to "cut them off". Unit 1 abruptly came to a stop and the Rushmer's continued northbound through the intersection.

Another witness, Gary Blurton said he was behind the Rushmer's in a different vehicle, northbound on Nichols Blvd. He had a green light and was going to turn right on Louisiana St. As Blurton began to turn right, he said Unit 1 quickly turned in front of him onto eastbound Louisiana St. and struck the two females who were walking in the crosswalk.

I asked Coe what happened. Coe stated she was southbound on Nichols Blvd. She said she had a "green arrow" to turn left so she turned left onto Louisiana St. She said she didn't see the two pedestrians until it was too late and struck the pedestrians with her vehicle.

I contacted Charity and Jeraldine at the hospital. Charity told me she and her mother Jeraldine were walking the lake. They stopped at the northeast corner of Louisiana St./Nichols Blvd. intersection while the crossing signal said don't walk. Once the crossing signal said "Walk", they started walking southbound across Louisiana St. Charity said she didn't see the vehicle driving towards them but remembered hitting the ground. Charity said she and her mom were walking side by side and Charity was closest to Nichols Blvd., on the right side of Jeraldine.

I issued Coe an infraction for Failing to Yield to Pedestrian in Crosswalk.

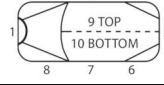

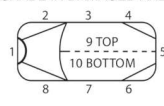

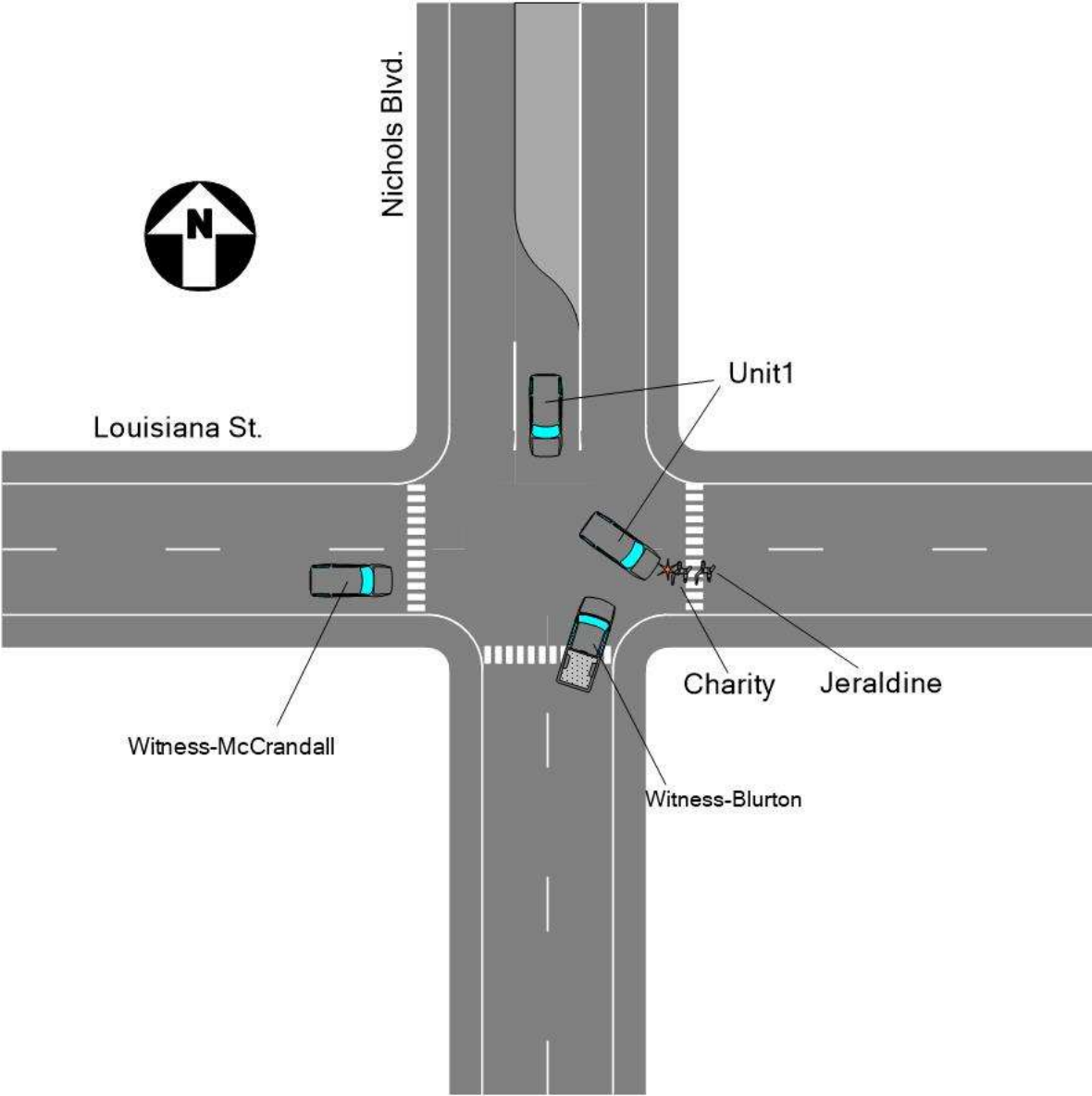
