Morgan met with the Washington Way contractor today and they plan to start in May. The Beech St project is being presented at Council on Thursday with a recommendation for award. Morgan spoke on the Transportation Improvement Board grant funded Complete Street projects - Olympia Way, Hudson, and 30th and proposed modifications. Chris Collins suggested a parking study on 30th Ave so that we

have that data ahead of this project.

There was a request for the reasoning behind removing the light at 20th & Washington Way. Chris and Sam provided justification and with the road diet, it will be only one lane each direction rather than two lanes on Washington Way as it is now.
