25-00529 RESOLUTION NO. 2561 - RECLAIM - RESTORING ENFORCEMENT, CLEANING LAWLESSNESS AND IMPROVING MUNICIPAL SPACES, DECLARING A PUBLIC NUISANCE IN CITY PARKS AND PUBLIC SPACES AND DIRECTING IMMEDIATE, FULL ENFORCEMENT OF THE LAW TO RESTORE ORDER, SAFETY, AND CIVILITY THROUGHOUT CITY-OWNED PROPERTY

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

MOTION TO ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2561

A motion was made by Councilmember Halvorson, seconded by Mayor Boudreau, to adopt Resolution No. 2561.

An amendment to the motion was made by Councilmember LaFave, seconded by Councilmember Halvorson. Councilmember LaFave read her amendment.

City Manager Jennifer Wills explained removing RCW's from the resolution, makes it broader. Council discussed the amendment.

An amendment to the amended motion was made by Councilmember Wean, seconded by Councilmember Wallis to change the title - "A Resolution of the City of Longview supporting the Longview Police Department and the 3 E's (Educate, Encourage, Enforce) insuring safety and protection for the community".

Council discussed the amendment to the amendment.

The amendment to the amended motion passed by the following vote:

Nays: Councilmember Halvorson, Councilmember Young, Mayor Boudreau

An amendment to the amendment to the main motion was made by Councilmember Wallis, seconded by Councilmember Kendall, to reword Bullet #1 - strike "declares a zero tolerance policy" and replace that with the three E's approach policy with its definition. Also strike part of the last sentence "and the city will no longer tolerate any violations of the law in these locations".

Nays: Councilmember Young, Councilmember LaFave, Councilmember Halvorson, Mayor Boudreau.
