*Morgan Palmer shared the information that was gathered at the Downtown Advisory Committee meeting last week. Liz Borders, Chair of the DAC and part of The Broad Strokes Project, shared a brief overview of the proposed project. Sam Barham spoke on some challenges that are presented from MUTCD and recent guidelines sent to about art on streets. Chris Collins reiterated that safety is our number one concern. Discussion included art decisions, locations possibly allowed, the higher traffic numbers on 15th, distractions for drivers, and paintings in mid block vs. intersections. Next steps are more research before we proceed. The desire is to continue with the work that we are doing to promote the activities we have doing Downtown - Summer on Broadway and a way to connect the Civic Circle Park to Downtown. Morgan walked through the next steps that he shared in the packet.*

*There was a discussion about the continued confusion on our various bike lanes projects around town. There was a suggestion to provide some education to the community for drivers and how to share the road with cyclists. The number one thing would be Right Hand Turns with a bike lane. A suggestion was made to contact the local driving schools to see if they are teaching bike safety to new drivers. Hand signals for bikers was discussed.*

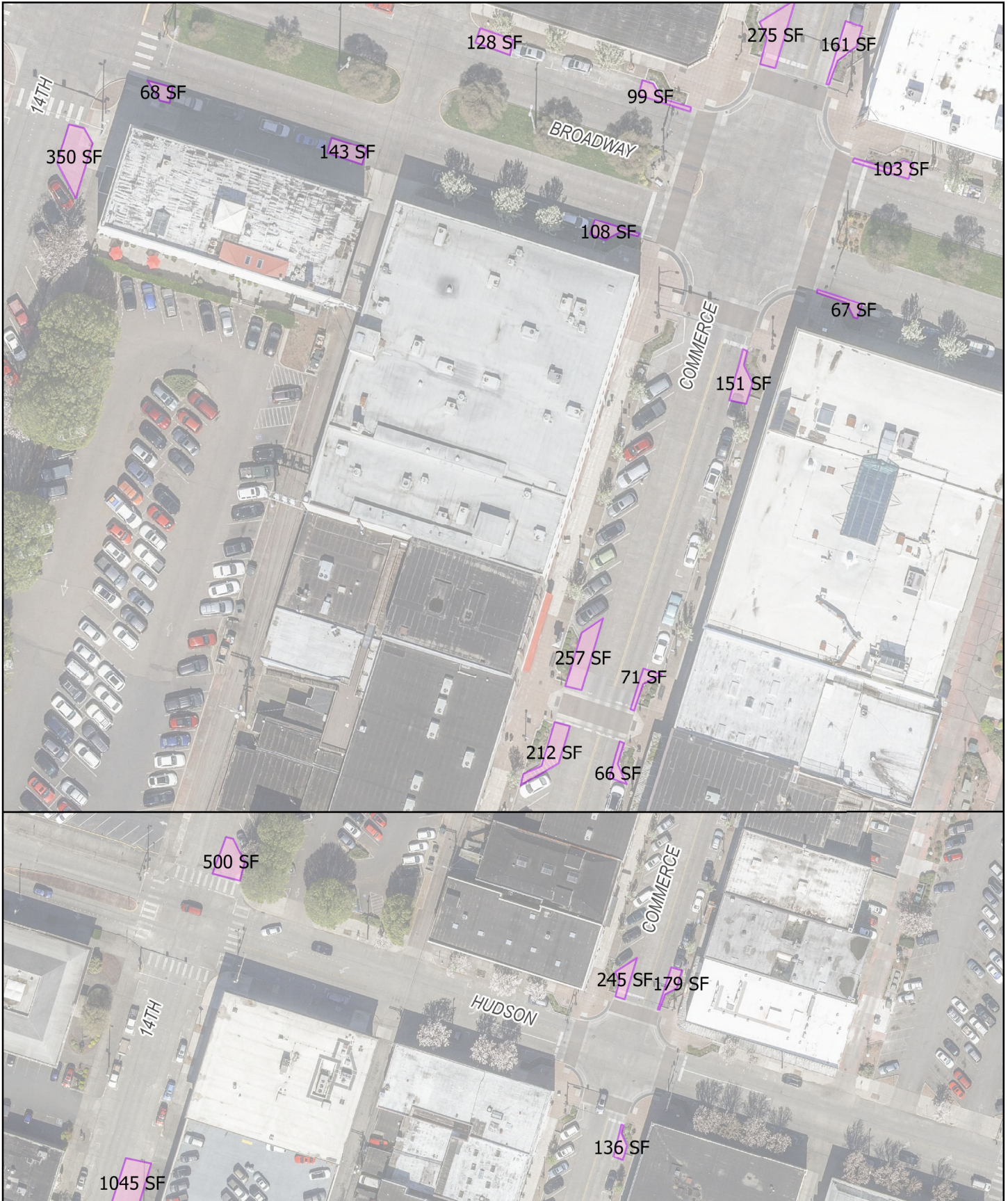
