1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Coddington called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

3. INVOCATION*/FLAG SALUTE

The flag salute was recited.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**25-001046 September 15, 2025 Regular Meeting**

A motion was made by Member Rudberg, seconded by Member Howell, to approve the September 15, 2025, Accessibility Advisory Committee Regular Meeting Minutes. The motion carried.

5. CONSTITUENT COMMENTS**6. COMMITTEE MEMBER COMMENTS & REPORTS****7. STAFF COMMENTS & REPORTS**

Transit Mobility Supervisor Doreen Dagget reported that the 511 bus will be changed from a 24-foot bus to a 35-foot bus to accommodate the need for more room for people and bicycles.

City Engineer Sam Barham reported that the Cloney Park project upgrade is out to bid. Parks and Rec Director Justin Brown reported that he will have more updates to share in several months.

Barham reported that the Downtown Advisory Committee (DAC) was provided with approved areas to paint. The approved areas are "dead spaces" around downtown rather than crosswalks. Councilmember Wallis reported that the DAC was pleased with the location compromise.

8. OLD BUSINESS**25-001042 Update on Ocean Beach and Mt. Solo Pedestrian Crossing**

Safety/Risk Manager Rashelle Douglas reported that after multiple outreach attempts over several months to the individual who brought forward the concerns, no response was received. \$80k had been dedicated to this project and there was \$61K remaining in the budget after.

A motion was made by Member Hendrickson, seconded by Vice Chair Vickers, to reallocate the \$80k. The motion carried.

25-001045 Accessibility and Mobility Survey Responses Review

The Committee discussed the responses received from the Accessibility and Mobility Survey. Many responses discussed transportation needs and sidewalk hazards. The sidewalk repair list was requested from Engineering.

The Committee discussed survey responses concerned with the accessibility of businesses. However, there is not always an enforceable code to address these concerns. Councilmember Wallis suggested bringing these concerns to the DAC, who could potentially educate and work with business owners. Barham discussed the use of GIS for creating an ADA priority map.

The Committee formed a subcommittee to review the survey responses in depth and prioritize needs. Vice Chair Vickers, Member Howell, and Member Lewis agreed to join the subcommittee and will provide a report at the next meeting.

9. NEW BUSINESS**25-001043 Tennant Way Corridor Crosswalks**

City Engineer Sam Barham provided an update on the Tennant Way Corridor project. Barham reported that there has been substantial completion from the contractor from 15th Ave down to 9th Ave, which received signal timer and push-button upgrades.

25-001044 Access to Bus Stop at 52nd and Ocean Beach from the South Side of the Road

Chair Coddington shared a concern that there are no curb-cut crosswalks in this area and inquired if there is a way to make this location more accessible. City Engineer Sam Barham discussed the options for pedestrian crossings, keeping in mind that there is currently no need for an additional traffic signal in this area. Pedestrian crossing systems could be considered, but there would need to be a significant demand.
