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2. **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm.

4. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

26-00601 **MINUTES FROM JUNE 23, 2026**

The minutes were approved as presented. This passed unanimously.

5. **PROJECT UPDATES**

26-00602 **SYSTEMIC PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS**

Morgan Palmer shared that the outcome of our community outreach on the Garfield/Harding/Hemlock intersection proposed changes was not in support of the proposal. The intersection was reworked, and a new concept is being presented.

Questions that were discussed:

- *Does this proposal make it safer?*
- *Multiple other reconfigurations?*
- *Is there funding to put RRFBs on the other crosswalks?*
- *Can lighting at the intersection be improved?*
- *Can raised sidewalks be added?*

Citizens attending were in favor of the changes for the Magnolia intersection as proposed at the community meeting. They attended to learn more about the removal of overhead lights was concerning. Morgan explained that there are lights above the flashers that will be removed. They are in favor of the proposed design as presented tonight.

Morgan shared that there is an online survey active now for this proposal. Final design is needed soon to get the funding in place. Morgan will bring this back to CSAC.

6. OTHER BUSINESS

26-00603 E-BIKES DISCUSSION

Morgan Palmer shared that there is a presentation tonight at Council. James Goodman will be presenting it from a legal and police point of view. We will bring back what happened at Council tonight. This will be an ongoing topic and education is greatly needed. It was suggested we look into how Utah is dealing with e-bike regulations.

It was requested to have a stop sign added to each block on 28th Ave.

The stop sign was added at Louisiana and Kessler - this has made a noticeable positive difference in the flow of traffic.
